1. Enrollment

April 2018 enrollment

1. Medical Science Specialty
Admission Capacity: 72 students
Aim: This program educates researchers to become capable of conducting creative research in the fields of basic and clinical science. They will become competent in the elucidation of the mechanisms of disease and the development of new therapeutic approaches.
2. Applied Medicine Specialty
Admission Capacity: 8 students
Aim: The program educates students to become medical professionals who are competent in cancer therapy and who can plan and conduct full-scale clinical trials that envision quality therapy in clinical medicine, as well as curative treatments; and also to become competent to work in other medically relevant fields.

September 2018 enrollment

1. Medical Science Specialty
Admission Capacity: Not determined
Aim: This program educates researchers to become capable of conducting creative researches in the fields of basic and clinical science. They will become competent in the elucidation of the mechanisms of disease and the development of new therapeutic approaches.

2. Eligibility for Admission

April 2018 enrollment

1. Applicants who have completed or who expect to complete 18 years of full-time education majoring in Medicine, Dentistry, Veterinary Medicine, or Pharmacy at the university level before enrollment are eligible.
2. Applicants who have completed or expect to complete a Master's program in a relevant field before enrollment are eligible.
3. Applicants who have completed 16 years of full-time education and have afterwards completed at least two years of research at a university or research institution are eligible. Such applicants' research must be of equal or higher quality than that of graduates who majored in Medicine, Dentistry, Veterinary Medicine, or Pharmacy at a Japanese university.
4. Applicants who have been determined by Keio University to be as capable as those who have completed an undergraduate program (majoring Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacology or Veterinary Medicine).

Note:

Applicants must email the Office of Student Services to confirm their eligibility at least a month prior to each application period.

4. Application Process

Step1) Web Entry for Online Application

Applicants must complete their web entry during the prescribed period and submit the completed web entry page by post with the other application documents.

Step3) Application documents submission

All application documents listed below must be sent to Office of Student Services, Keio University Shinanomachi Campus, 35 Shinanomachi, Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo 160-8582, Japan, by a method that allows tracking, such as EMS and couriers (e.g. FedEx, DHL etc.).

1. A copy of the completed web entry page
2. Application form (4 pages) with signature and seal of the professor who will be the applicant's research supervisor at Keio University (if you cannot obtain the professor's signature and seal, please attach his/her letter of consent)
3. Research plan
4. A reference written by the applicant's current academic supervisor or someone who has previously supervised the applicant's studies
5. Certificate of graduation or statement of expected graduation from undergraduate and/or master's program
6. Academic transcripts for undergraduate and/or master's program

7. Application card
8. Two photos taken within the last three months (these should be pasted onto the application form and application card)
 - Print size H: 40 mm x W: 30 mm
 - Face and shoulders, directly facing the camera
 - Plain background
9. Proof of payment of the application fee: applicants should print out the 'Application Completed' page when they have completed online payment by credit card

2. Application forms, documents, and fees paid cannot be returned or refunded.
3. After the application has been officially processed, an examination ticket will be sent by email to the applicant. This should be printed and carried by the applicant on the examination day.

- (10) Immunization Record (measles, rubella, chicken pox, mumps)
- (11) Tuition and Fees (bank transfer receipt)
- (12) Application forms for Certificate of Eligibility
